We asked Chris to check into not paying employee benefits to employee spouses after a divorce. He said we needed to check if the town voted on GL. C.32B S9h. Jill has done some research and checked with the Town Clerk on this and is fairly certain that the selectmen did not vote on this. We can proceed forward on writing a new policy once we are completely sure.

- There was discussion about how the Town of Sterling obtained a grant to install a battery back-up to provide power to the town in case of a power outage. Maybe with the help of Jeanne LeClair that is something the CMELD could look into.

- The commissioners agreed to give the employees December 24 and December 31 off with pay to the employees.
