## Requirements for Septic System New Installation or Repair

- For existing system: Have a Title V test done, send test results to the Board of Health via email to <a href="mailto:Chesterhealth@comcast.net">Chesterhealth@comcast.net</a>
- 2) For new system: Conduct a percolation test, the results of this test will determine the soil conditions. Fee is \$200 for the first two hours (min), \$100 per hour after. Fill out perc form available online at <a href="http://townofchester.net/permits-forms/">http://townofchester.net/permits-forms/</a> and at the BOH office, and send in fee payable to The Town of Chester.
- 3) Have an engineer draw up an installation plan and submit one paper copy and also a PDF copy via email to <a href="Chesterhealth@comcast.net">Chesterhealth@comcast.net</a> along with a Septic Plan Review Form available online at <a href="http://townofchester.net/permits-forms/">http://townofchester.net/permits-forms/</a> and at the BOH office, and send in fee of \$100 payable to The Town of Chester. Once received this will be forwarded to the town Health Agent for approval.
- 4) Once approved apply for a Construction Works Permit. This permit covers two inspections by the town Health Agent. Fee is \$250 available online at <a href="http://townofchester.net/permits-forms/">http://townofchester.net/permits-forms/</a> and at the BOH office, and send in fee payable to The Town of Chester. Once received by the BOH you way begin construction of the septic system.
- 5) Upon completion and two inspections, a Certificate of Compliance Form, Fee is \$100 and is available online at <a href="http://townofchester.net/permits-forms/">http://townofchester.net/permits-forms/</a> will be signed off by the engineer, installer, Health Inspector and finally the BOH.

All emails are answered within 24 hours. The BOH requires digital drawings and plans. Septic Installers must be licensed in the Town of Chester annually.
