ARTICLE 1:

To authorize the Board of Selectmen to appoint such other Town Officials as are not required to be chosen by ballot, or take any other action relative thereto.

FY2021 Operating Budget

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds, the sum of \$3,432,673.00 to defray the charges and expenses of the Town, including debt service (principal and interest) and to provide a Reserve Fund, for the period July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021, as set forth in the attached budget sheet and further, to hear the report of the Finance Committee and act thereon, or to take any other action relative thereto. ARTICLE 4

Revolving Funds

To see if the Town will vote to set FY2021 spending limits for each of the Town's previously established revolving funds that have been authorized by Chapter 44, Section 53E1/2 of the Massachusetts General Law as indicated below; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 5: Alternative Assessment method for Gateway Regional School District

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds the sum of \$1,612,008.00 for the Gateway Regional School District as determined using the "Alternative Assessment Method" as set forth in the regional school district agreement for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30,2021; or to take any other action relative thereto. (Last year's figure \$1,581,065.00).

ARTICLE 6:

Vocational Tuition and Transportation

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds, the sum of \$249,900 to pay for vocational tuition (\$209,000.00) and transportation (\$40,3000.00) for Chester students for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30,2021; or to take any other action relative thereto. (Last year's figure \$253,985.00).

ARTICLE 7:

Acceptance of Chapter 90 Funds

To see if the Town will vote to accept and appropriate funds being provided by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, under the provisions of Mass. General Laws Chapter 90. Such funds to be used to pay costs as allowed by appropriate legislation in connection with the maintenance, repair, and construction of Town ways and bridges; and provided that any unspent funds shall carry over from year to year until expended by the Town or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 8:

CMELD Operations

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the income from the sale of electricity to private consumers, municipal building and jobbing for the Municipal Electric Light Department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and to authorize that the whole be expended under the direction and control of the Board of Electric Light Commissioners and Manager: or to take any other action relative thereto.

Majority votes required

ARTICLE 9: Hilltown Ambulance Replacement Fund

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$2,825.00 to the Hilltown Ambulance replacement fund or to take any action relative thereto.

Majority vote required

ARTICLE 10: Fire Truck Replacement Stabilization Fund

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$25,000 to the Fire Truck Replacement Stabilization Fund, or to take any action relative thereto.

Majority vote required

ARTICLE 11: GIS Mapping Services

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$2,500.00 to upgrade the GIS mapping system in the Assessor's office, provided that any remaining funds will be closed out to the undesignated fund balance at the close of Fiscal Year 2022; or to take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 12: Town Hall Maintenance Stabilization Fund

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$5,000.00 to the Town Hall Maintenance Stabilization Fund; or to take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 13: Town's Sanitary Survey

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$45,000.00 to cover the costs for technical assistance with the Town's Sanitary Survey for the Water Department, provided that any remaining funds will be closed out to the undesignated fund balance at the close of Fiscal Year 2022 or to take

ARTICLE 14:

Highway Truck Replacement

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money not to exceed \$100,000 to fund the purchase of a 2019 F550 Truck with a plow to determine whether to do so by authorizing the Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to borrow under Chapter 44, Sec. 7 of the General Laws, or any other enabling authority; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 15:

Quill FY2019 invoice

To see if the Town will vote to authorize payment of an invoice from June 2019 in the amount of \$205.95, or to take any other action relative thereto.

4/5 vote required

ARTICLE 16:

William Street-Acceptance of Public Way

To see if the Town will vote to accept as a public way, as laid out and reported by the Board of Selectmen, the extension of William Street shown as "Parcel A" on a "Plan of Land to Be Gifted to the Inhabitants of Town of Chester, Massachusetts" by Salvini Associates dated May 9, 2016, and recorded with the Hampden County Registry of Deeds at Plan Book 388, Page 108, a copy of which is on file with Town Clerk; or take any other action in relation thereto.

2/3 vote required

ARTICLE 17:

Education Stabilization account

To see if the Town will vote to create a Education Stabilization Fund pursuant to G.L.c.4,ss5B for the purpose to assist of funding assessments made by regional school districts of which the Town is a member community: to appropriate thereto a sum not to exceed \$82,784; and to determine whether to do so by raising and appropriating some or all of said amount from tax levy or by transfer from available funds; or to take any other action relative thereto.

2/3 Vote required
