- Due to the cost Jill thought that we should not continue with the Tree Trimming this summer and fall on Johnson Hill or Skyline Trail. Although she will get some other bids to see what prices we can get.
- Gas pump parts have been ordered.
- Next meeting will be held Tuesday, September 28, 2021 at 6:00 pm. This will be a joint meeting with the Selectboard.
