First quarter FY 2022 tax bills will be in your mail box shortly. The due date is August 2, 2021. If you fail to get a tax bill and you are expecting it, please call. Interest will begin accruing on any unpaid balances the day after the due date. Interest will not be waived anymore! Interest charged will reduce the amount of principal you are paying. Motor Vehicle bills are also going out periodically, **BRIGHTLY** colored demand bills as well. Please do not ignore these. There are over a 150 people who have not paid motor vehicle bills for years, until it gets time to renew their license or registration and then it is an emergency. Don't let this happen to you. #### **Just a couple reminders from CMELD:**

- Bills are always mailed the first week of every month.
- Payments received during the last week of the month may not be reflected on your new bill.
- Past due and shut off notices are based on the number of days of non-payment, not account balance. \*
   Payments must be received on or before the discount due date in order to be eligible for the discount.
- The discount is like a coupon, once the expiration date is reached, it is no longer valid.
- Paperless billing is now available, email <u>cmeldad-min@townofchester.net</u> to request paperless billing.
- Include the email address you wish to receive your bill at, your account number, property address and a valid phone number.
- Payments can be dropped 24/7 in the black lock box on the Town Hall steps.
- Payments can be made on line by following the links on the WWW.TOWNOFCHESTER.NET website.
- CMELD works with customers to develop budget or payment plans.

Happy summer and remember permits renew July 1<sup>st</sup> at the Transfer Station. The Transfer Station is open Wednesdays 3pm to 6pm and Saturdays 9am to 1pm for Chester residents. A yearly permit is required to use the transfer station, they can be purchased at the attendant's shed during operating hours for \$65.00, cash or check. Additional stickers for households are \$5.00 each. The permit gives Chester residents access to free cardboard/paper and plastic/glass recycling. Rubbish requires a bag sticker (\$3.00 each) use your own trash bag up to a 33-gallon size. We also accept demo/bulky items, metal, electronics, weed whackers, appliances and more.
