

Materials Currently **Banned or to be Banned** from Disposal or Transfer for Disposal in Massachusetts

- Asphalt pavement, brick and concrete
- Cathode ray tubes
- Clean gypsum wallboard
- [Commercial food material](#) (lower threshold effective November 1, 2022)
- Ferrous and non-ferrous metals
- Glass and metal containers
- Lead acid batteries
- Leaves and yard waste
- [Mattresses](#) (effective November 1, 2022)
- [Recyclable paper, cardboard and paperboard recycling available at Transfer Station](#)
- Single-resin narrow-necked plastic containers
- [Textiles](#) (effective November 1, 2022) no clothing, rugs, mattresses, futons, etc.
- Treated and untreated wood and wood waste (banned from landfills only)
- White goods (large appliances) [recycling available at Chester Transfer Station for a fee](#)
- [Whole tires \(banned from landfills only; shredded tires acceptable\) recycling available at Chester Transfer Station for a fee see attendant for size restrictions](#)
