Materials Currently <mark>Banned or to be Banned</mark> from Disposal or Transfer for Disposal in Massachusetts

- Asphalt pavement, brick and concrete
- Cathode ray tubes
- Clean gypsum wallboard
- Commercial food material (lower threshold effective November 1, 2022)
- Ferrous and non-ferrous metals
- Glass and metal containers
- Lead acid batteries
- Leaves and yard waste
- <u>Mattresses</u> (effective November 1, 2022)
- Recyclable paper, cardboard and paperboard recycling available at Transfer Station
- Single-resin narrow-necked plastic containers
- <u>Textiles</u> (effective November 1, 2022) no clothing, rugs, mattresses, futons, etc.
- Treated and untreated wood and wood waste (banned from landfills only)
- White goods (large appliances) recycling available at Chester Transfer Station for a fee
- Whole tires (banned from landfills only; shredded tires acceptable) recycling available at Chester Transfer Station for a fee see attendant for size restrictions
