Article 2:

CORNERSTONE CHURCH

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to accept as a gift for general municipal purposes the so-called Cornerstone Church property located at 1 Middlefield Road, Chester; and further to authorize the Board of Selectmen to take any other action deemed appropriate in relation to such acquisition; or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 3:

STARKWEATHER PASTURE

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to convey a certain land-locked property located off South Worthington Road, known as Starkweather Pasture (about 50 acres), to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Fish and Game, as described in a deed recorded with the Hampden County Registry of Deeds in Book 1610, page 482, on such terms and conditions, and for such consideration, as the Board of Selectmen deems in the best interest of the Town; and further to authorize the Board of Selectmen to take any other action deemed appropriate in relation thereto; or take any other action relative thereto.

HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from Free Cash the sum of no more than \$29,000 to undertake the process of updating the Town's Hazard Mitigation Plan; or take any other action relative thereto.

TOWN CLERK COMPUTER

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$1,337.54 to replace the Town Clerk computer; or take any other action relative thereto.

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from Water Department Free Cash the following sums of money needed to pay the following bills incurred in FY2023; or take any other action relative thereto:
