

JOB DESCRIPTION

Working Foreman

SUMMARY:

As an employee of the Chester Municipal Electric Light Department, the Working Foreman position will oversee the day-to-day operations of the line crew and report to the General Manager. This Lineworker will be classified as a Troubleman. The position is part-time 16 hours weekly.

PRIMARY ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Schedules daily work for line crew and oversee the successful completion of such work
 - Maintenance and construction of primary overhead power distribution systems
 - Necessary tree trimming to maintain lines
 - Maintenance and construction of secondary overhead power lines
 - Read meters as needed
 - Installing and removing meters as necessary
 - Planning and estimating line construction
 - Care and servicing of trucks and related equipment
 - Care and maintenance of town streetlights
 - Training and instruction of back-up personnel
 - Mutual Aid to other MELDs
 - Scheduling and Attendance of classes and safety meetings
 - On call for trouble call outs
 - Additional duties as assigned
- Pay range \$45.00 - \$55.00 per hour.

Like all employees, the Working Foreman is expected to be a team player, asking for assistance and assisting co-workers, work safely and promote safety, open communication and present a favorable impression of the company.

This description is not intended to be a complete statement of the position, but to act as a guide to the general work performed.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

CDL License Class B, minimum 5 years Power Lineman experience, Mass. Hoisting #1-B
Ability to work outdoors in all conditions for extended periods of time.
