Chester Water Commission Minutes April 6, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9am with Tim Moriarty, Craig Gauthier, Bob Daley, Tom Bean, Moe Boisseau & son, Lyle Snide and Jim Zimmerman in attendance. Minutes of the previous meeting were read, accepted and signed. Bob spoke about the PVPC phase 2 drainage project. Tom spoke about the water line connected to the jail. Moe spoke about what he found in the ground during the excavation of a leak on Maple Street. Tim spoke about doing taps to the line put in during a project in the 90's. We will need to excavate to discover what connections exist between the two lines. Bob will see if Jon Tibbits can locate the lines by going off the curb stops. Hopefully we can determine where the lines actually lie. Also will need to be prepared in case a shutoff valve needs to be installed. We spoke about the next stage of remediation of the Horn Pond access road. It will need stone and not millings at this point. We also spoke about reestablishing the 800 foot of line at Horn Pond to the deeper part of the Pond. Tim will order air separators for the water pumps at the plant. We also spoke about the cost of the pipe for Horn Pond and will check with Colin Powers of T & B for help with logistics and possible grants. When we establish the location of piping on Maple Street we will make sure to update the GIS to reflect that location and type of pipe. The meeting closed at 10:38am.
